- 3. Elbert Hubbard states, "We are punished by our sins not for them." How is this different from what the disciples in John 9:2 have assumed?
- 4. What does it mean to be punished by our sins rather than for our sins?
- 5. To find healing and reverse the pressure, we need to move toward Jesus. How does doing this help? Read Matthew 11:28-30.
- 6. John 9:13-34 tells of the conflict between the religious leaders and Jesus. What role does pride play in keeping the religious leaders from accepting Jesus' work?
- 7. How does pride keep us from moving toward Jesus?
- 8. In order to reverse the pressure, our eyes have to be opened. What do our eyes need to be opened to?
- 9. How do we partner with God in the healing work he wants to do 1) to open our own eyes, and 2) to help open the eyes of others?
- 10. Hopelessness seems to surround us. What things tend to increase your sense of hopelessness?
- 11. What do you feel most hopeless about right now?
- 12. Read Ephesians 1:18. Where do you need God to step in and show you hope?
- 13. What can you do to move toward Jesus and hope this week?
