- 5. What does the new and better wine represent in this story? (cf. Jeremiah 31:10-14)
- 6. From John 2:1-12, what resulted from Jesus doing this miracle? Why do you think it had this result?
- 7. This story tells of something new, like never before, happening. Have you ever received new information that stopped you in your tracks and changed how you responded or viewed the situation?
- This story results in joy. How would you describe or identify "joy"? (John 15:9-13)
- 9. When you think of following Jesus, do you think of "joy"? Why or why not?
- 10. How could learning and focusing on this story create joy in your life and others?
