- 4. Read Proverbs 3:13-18. What stands out to you from this passage, and why? Is there anything that surprises or confuses you about it?
- 5. The passage suggests that those who find wisdom find life and receive favor from the Lord. How does wisdom contribute to a fulfilling and blessed life according to these verses?
- 6. In the context of these verses, how does the fear of the Lord connect with the acquisition of wisdom? What role does reverence for God play in the pursuit of wisdom?
- 7. Jesus' arrival epitomized the way of wisdom. Read James 3:13-18. How does the passage define and differentiate between heavenly wisdom and earthly wisdom?
- 8. The passage suggests that wisdom leads to a harvest of righteousness. What does this metaphor imply about the long-term effects and outcomes of living a wise and righteous life?
- 9. What are somethings that can help us grow in wisdom?
- 10. Looking back over 2023, are there areas you can identify where you lacked wisdom? Or rejected someone's wise counsel?
- 11. In what areas do you foresee needing wisdom in 2024? Take time as a group to pray about those areas.
