- 8. What part of Romans 8:31-39 is most compelling for your faith?
- 9. If God is fully giving himself, unconditionally, in love, why would someone not want to respond by giving their life back to God? What things might get in the way?
- 10. In your response to God, what things cause you to hesitate?
- 11. Pastor John stated that we have to be all in. What would being all in look like for you?
- 12. What areas of your life have kept you from being "all in"?
- 13. What is something you can do this week that will help you press into this relationship even more?
