- 6. If those who follow Jesus have "died to sin", why do you think Paul commands action on our part when it comes to sin (Romans 6:12-13; Galatians 2:20 and Galatians 5:24-25)?
- There is a shift that takes place in Romans 6:13, from sin to life. How does this positive purpose affect your focus and your progress? (Cf. Romans 6:17; Philippians 3:12-14)
- 8. What positive purpose or spiritual focus do you feel challenged to take up this week that will help you step beyond the influence of sin?
