

My Prayers Aren't Answered

John 11:1, 3-6, 17-21: "Now a man named Lazarus was sick. He was from Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha... **3** So the sisters sent word to Jesus, 'Lord, the one you love is sick.'**4** When he heard this, Jesus said, 'This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's Son may be glorified through it.' **5** Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. **6** So when he heard that Lazarus was sick, he stayed where he was two more days... On his arrival, Jesus found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days. **18** Now Bethany was less than two miles from Jerusalem, **19** and many Jews had come to Martha and Mary to comfort them in the loss of their brother. **20** When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went out to meet him, but Mary stayed at home.**21** 'Lord,' Martha said to Jesus, 'if you had been here, my brother would not have died...'"

Romans 5:3,4: "...we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; **4** perseverance, character; and character, hope."

James 1:2-5: "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, **3** because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. **4** Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. **5** If any of you lacks wisdom..."
