- 2. What are important elements for a witness to have? Or qualities of a testimony?
- 3. What stood out to you most from Sunday's message? Why?
- 4. Read Acts 1:1-8. What are Jesus' followers called to "witness" or "testify" to?
- 5. In Acts 1, how did Jesus' followers incorrectly interpret the coming of the Holy Spirit? How does it speak to their misunderstanding of power?
- 6. What role does the Holy Spirit have in witnessing to the life and message of Jesus? Read also Luke 24:44-49, Acts 4:31 and John 16:13 in your response.
- 7. Jesus' death and resurrection occur on Passover, what significance does this have?
- 8. Pastor John stated that Passover is about identity. How is the Passover story supposed to shape the identity of Jesus' followers?
- 9. In a stroke of irony, during Passover, a dispute breaks out among Jesus' followers about who would be the greatest (Luke 22:24-27). Does a pursuit for being the greatest obstruct the task of being an accurate witness to Jesus? If so, how?
- 10. How does following the way of Jesus, with all that it teaches about power, make the message of Jesus more appealing?
- 11. What area of your life do you need to bring into alignment with this week's message?
- 12. Where do you feel God challenging you to better follow Him as His witness in this world?
