- 3. What comes to mind when you think of your gifts? "Gifts" might sound odd, what other words might be synonymous with gifts?
- 4. We grow relationally when we are responding to the needs of others and holding each other accountable. Why are the gifts essential in the process of growth and accountability?
- 5. How does "sober judgment" in Romans 12:3 inform our use of gifts and holding each other accountable?
- 6. Read Galatians 6:1-2. In the interview with Justin Hartley, who plays Kevin, he states no one was willing to respond to his need. What do these verses challenge us to? How do we practically do this?

7.	Read Romans 4:17. What hope do we have that something new can come about in our relationships?
8.	How do you find hope when relationships are going poorly? Why is this difficult? And what helps make it easier?
