- 6. Why do you think Jesus takes such a strong stance against anger, calling someone a fool (idiot, or *raca*) and cursing someone?
- 7. What is the difference between forgiveness and reconciliation?
- 8. Read Colossians 3:8-15. What does Paul instruct us to do in these verses? What rationale or reasons does he give for living this way?
- 9. How do these verses relate to the Beatitudes in Matthew 5:1-12? In what ways do these instructions help shape the people of God?
- 10. Which one(s) tend to be the most difficult for you?
- 11. What is the best advice you have been given on how to deal with anger? Or best advice on extending forgiveness?
- 12. What would you like to change about the way you deal with anger?
- 13. How do you feel God calling you to respond to this week's message and discussion? What do you hope will be different because of this information?
