Romans 1:17-21: "17 For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: 'The righteous will live by faith.

¹⁸ The <u>wrath</u> of God is being <u>revealed</u> from heaven against all the <u>godlessness</u> and <u>wickedness</u> of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, ¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. ²⁰ For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

²¹ For although they knew God, they neither <u>glorified</u> him as God nor <u>gave thanks</u> to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened.
