- 8. Ephesians 4:3 emphasizes the importance of maintaining the unity of the Spirit. In what ways can the church actively pursue and preserve unity, especially when faced with differences in beliefs and practices?
- 9. What are the ways that we respond to the call of following Jesus? Pick one of the traits and describe what that might look like in your context.
- 10. Which ones do you find most difficult? Or, where do you feel God might be challenging you to grow in?
- 11. Where do you need God's light and life in your heart toward "those people"?
