

## Jesus on Divorce

## **Context Creates Clarity**

Matthew 19:3-10(ESV): "And Pharisees came up to him and tested him by asking, 'Is it lawful to divorce one's wife for?' <sup>4</sup> He answered, 'Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female, <sup>5</sup> and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? <sup>6</sup> So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.' <sup>7</sup> They said to him, 'Why then did Moses one to give a certificate of divorce and to send her away?' <sup>8</sup> He said to them, "Because of your Moses your wives, but from the beginning it was not
so. <sup>9</sup> And I say to you: whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery.' <sup>10</sup> The disciples said to him, 'If such is the case of
a man with his wife, it is better not to marry."
