- 3. Read John 13:1-17. What stands out to you from Jesus' words to his disciples? Why does that stand out?
- 4. What do you think left the biggest impact on Jesus' disciples?
- 5. Why do you think Jesus chose to demonstrate this principle through washing feet?
- 6. Read Romans 12:3-10. In these verses, Paul describes the followers of Jesus as "the Body of Christ". How do these verses reinforce and further explain Jesus' teaching in John 13:1-7?
- 7. Despite everyone's differences, Romans 12 seems to communicate that we are all equal. What is the thing that makes us all equal in the sight of God?
- 8. How do these two passages speak to the fact that love functions best when we see each other as equal?
- 9. Derek stated, "The enemy of love is pride. Pride is self-centered, love is othercentered. You can love anyone if you believe that person is not beneath you." Where do you find it most challenging to see others as equal?
- 10. What types of different personalities or backgrounds do you find most difficult to love and serve as Jesus describes?
