- 2. What is the shift in Paul's perspective that required humility?
- 3. Pastor John stated, "if you're never wrong, you're not growing." What do you think it cost Paul to acknowledge that he was wrong?
- 4. What do you think Paul gained by acknowledging his error?
- 5. Can you think of a place where you've been wrong about your beliefs?
- 6. What was it that caused you to question that belief, to become curious about alternatives?
- 7. Read Matthew 13:10-18. Why do you think some people could see and hear what Jesus was really speaking about while others could not?
- 8. The disciples remained curious (Matthew 13:10), how do you develop curiosity?
- 9. What were the three benefits of curiosity? Which one was most intriguing to you? Why?
- 10. What keeps you from being (more) curious about God or the Bible?
- 11. In what area of your faith or knowledge do you feel you have the greatest need for growth?
- 12. What is one thing you can do this week to develop curiosity or act on your curiosity?
