- 7. Jesus' human emotions and experiences clearly resonated with the biblical authors (hence why they highlighted them). What impact do you think these stories should have on those who follow Jesus?
- 8. Take a moment to consider or reread Matthew 26:36-46. How does this passage speak to you?
- 9. How might Jesus' experience impact your perspective of your own experiences?
- 10. How will Jesus' humility and willingness to fall on his face in prayer affect your approach prayer?
- 11. What things are you facing right now that might require "falling with your face to the ground and praying"?
