## **QUESTIONS**

- 1. In general, when a new idea or activity is suggested are you more of a "yes", "no", or "maybe" type of person?
- 2. Is there someone in your life that you tend to always go along with; i.e. say "yes" more than "no" to? If so, why?
- 3. Mary had the faith to say "yes" to God when it meant a more complicated and challenging life. Have you ever felt like God was prompting you to do something? What did your response look like?
- 4. Mary says "yes" because she saw God as her "Lord". This is a matter of who is in control. When you think about life, what things tend to control or influence your decisions most?
- 5. How would your life look if you granted more control to God in your day-to-day decisions?
- 6. What does giving God control even look like practically speaking?
